Year 2 had a medieval treat at Chirk Castle

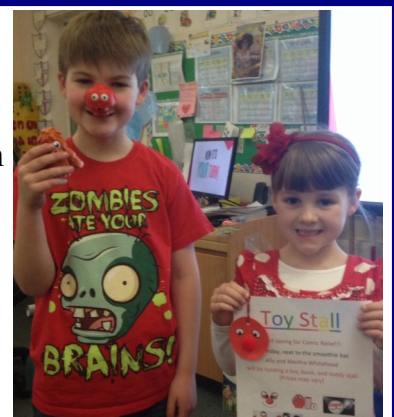


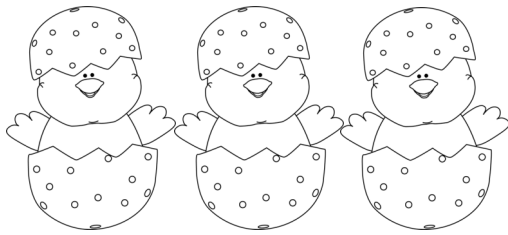
