They met illustrator Steve Antony and author Elen Caldecott, who signed one of her books for each of them to keep.








EXCITING DAYS OUT

Lots of children have been lucky enough to go on trips out during the past few weeks.




Year 6 pupils visited Llandudno; they paddled in the sea, rode to the top of the Great Orme on the tram, explored the pier and watched Punch and Judy.
